BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Parkhotel, which opened in 1903, was originally designed by the architect Karl Gottlieb Koller from Ragaz. It is located on the bank of Lake Lucerne, not far from the legendary Rütli. Guests of the Parkhotel include artists and actors from Switzerland and abroad, as well as personalities from business and industry. From 2009, the entire Parkhotel was converted to a hotel in brand new condition with three theme worlds, Wine & Dine, Art & Culture and Health & Wealth, and was fitted out with the most up-todate technical comfort features.
